

Categorization of reports processed by EACC in September 2011





4.2 Monthly Activities

Mombasa

- 1. Surveillance on corrupt activities at Kilindini Port and tax evasion at the border entry point of Taveta with a view of conducting a sting operation. Investigations are on-going.
- 2. Intelligence probe on a consignment of condemned sugar lying at the Customs warehouse Kilindini whose destruction has been put on hold due to vested interests by senior KRA officers. Investigations are on-going.
- 3. Intelligence probe on the on-going storm water drainage works undertaken by the Municipal Council of Mombasa and the water rehabilitation projects done by the Mombasa Water and Sewerage Company.

- 4. Completed Forensic Investigations into allegations of misappropriation of Constituency Development Funds in Ganze Constituency.
- 5. The department completed and forwarded a file on the traced assets of a senior traffic police officer suspected to have acquired unexplained wealth.
- 6. Intelligence probe into allegations that some unscrupulous importers are colluding with Clearing Agents to evade payment of Customs Warehouse Rent in respect to over 100 over stayed vehicles.
- 7. Joint forensic investigations into allegations of collusion by lands officers and other parties to fraudulently acquire of a 25 acre beach plot in Kwale i.e. Block 151/Kwale Diani Beach plots.

Kisumu

1. Preliminary inquiries/investigations into alleged illegal/irregular alienation of various plots within Busia municipality some of which were reserved for public purposes.
